#### ADDINGTONS IN ENGLAND

- ADDINGTONS OF VIRGINIA CONNECTIONS
   CAN BE TRACED TO THREE LOCATIONS:
  - LONDON
    - -HATTON GARDENS, 17<sup>TH</sup> AND 18<sup>TH</sup> CENTURIES
    - WERE DRY COOPERS LATER WET COOPERS
  - BEDFORDSHIRE NORTH OF LONDON
    - DNA MATCH
  - NORTHAMPTONSHIRE NORTH OF LONDON
    - VILLAGE OF LITCHBOROUGH







#### ADDINGTONS IN ENGLAND

- DRY COOPER MADE CASKS (WOODEN STAVED BARRELS) DESIGNED TO KEEP DRY GOODS DRY
  - USED TO SHIP DRY GOODS SUCH AS CEREALS, GRAIN, NAILS, GUNPOWER AND TOBACCO
- WET COOPER MADE CASKS DESIGNED FOR THE PROCESSING AND SHIPMENT OF LIQUID
  - USED IN THE MAKING AND SHIPMENT OF WINE







### WILLIAM'S PARENTS

- SIR WILLIAM ADDINGTON, CHRISTENING
   01 APRIL 1728, DIED 07 APRIL, 1811
  - -MARRIED 1) SISTER TO CAPT. RICHARD WILLIAMSON OF EYDON,
    NORTHHAMPSHIRE NO ISSUE
  - -MARRIED 2) CAROLINE LUMLEY, DIED 1807, DAUGHTER OF LORD SCARBOROUGH (VERY WEALTHY)

#### SIR WILLIAM ADDINGTON

- TOOK HOLY ORDER BUT DID NOT PRACTICE VERY LONG AS A CLERGYMAN
- JOINED THE 16<sup>TH</sup> LIGHT DRAGOONS AS A CORNET, WAS PROMOTED TO LIEUTENANT AND SERVED IN GERMANY
- BOW STREET MAGISTRATE FOR 28 YEARS
- WAS KNIGHTED IN 1797 FOR HIS PUBLIC SERVICE

### SIR WILLIAM ADDINGTON CON'T

- WROTE "ABRIDGEMENT OF PENAL STATUTES"
   IN 1775 FOUR EDITIONS
- LIVED AT 6 CROSS LANE (NOW ST. DUNSTAN'S LANE) HOME WAS SEVERELY DAMAGED DURING BLITZ OF 1941
- ATTENDED ST. DUNSTAN IN-THE-EAST CHURCH THE CHURCH WAS SEVERELY DAMAGED DURING BLITZ OF 1941 AND WAS NOT REBUILT
- RETIRED TO BATH, SOMERSET, ENGLAND
